One on One by John Feinstein describes his most interesting encounters with coaching and sports legends such as Bob Knight and Jack Nicklaus (Little Brown, \$27.99).

Locked On by Tom Clancy has Jack Ryan coming out of retirement to run for president and face the treachery of his opponent who uses made-up charges to attack one of Jack's closest friends (Putnam, \$28.95).

Kill Alex Cross by James Patterson is another thriller in the series in which Cross attempts to investigate the abduction of the president's son and daughter (Little Brown, \$28.99).

Thinking, Fast and Slow by Daniel Kahneman takes us on a tour of the mind and explains our two systems of thinking (Farrar, Straus and Giroux, \$30).

Stuck by Oliver Jeffers is a fun picture book in which Floyd's kite get stuck in a tree, and he goes to great lengths to free it (Philomel Books, \$16.99).

Star Wars Episode 1, The Phantom Menace comes with 3D glasses which make the action jump off the page (Scholastic, \$9.99).

Little Panda by Renata Liwske is a charming story about a little panda, Bao Bao and his mother, Lin Lin (Houghton Mifflin, \$5.99).

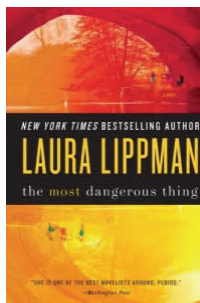
