New Books

Presidents of War by Michael Beschloss is a very readable chronicle of presidents who took us into conflict from the War of 1812 to Vietnam (Broadway Books, \$20).

The Authenticity Project by Clare Pooley is a novel about a 79-year-old artist who wonders what would happen if we all shared the truth of our lives. It all begins with a green notebook (Pamela Dorman Books, \$26).

Dear Edward by Ann Napolitano is the story of twelve-year-old Edward who is the sole survivor of an airplane crash which kills his older brother and his parents (Dial Press, \$27).

Why We're Polarized by Ezra Klein who suggests that the American political system is broken and reveals how the system itself is polarizing us (Avid Reader Press/Simon & Schuster, \$28).

Barracoon by Zora Neale Hurston is a never-before-published work about the last survivor of the slave trade (Amistad Press, \$16.99).

Yes No Maybe So by Becky Albertalli and Aisha Saeed is a young adult story about the power of love and resistance. (Balzer & Bray, \$17.99).

The Bug Girl by the bug girl herself, Sophia Spencer who loved bugs as a little girl, but she was teased by other kids as she got older and her interest continued (Schwartz and Wade Books, \$17.99).

Just a Dream by Chris Van Allsburg is the story of a little boy who has been careless about taking care of our earth, but in a dream sequence he begins to understand the importance of using our earth wisely (Sandpiper, \$8.99).


