Ook and Gluk: Kung Fu Cavemen from the Future by Dav Pilkey (Captain Underpants) is a graphic novel about Ook and Gluk growing up in Caveland, Ohio, in 500,001 BC until an evil corporation from the future invades their town (Blue Sky Press, \$9.99). Grades 3-4.

How Rocket Learned to Read by Tad Hills is the story of a little yellow bird who teaches Rocket, the dog, to read by introducing the alphabet (Schwartz & Wade Books, \$16.99).

The Tower, The Zoo and The Tortoise by Julia Smart is the story of Balthazar Jones who is a Beefeater and lives in the Tower of London with his wife and 120-year-old pet tortoise when things begin to fall apart (Doubleday, \$24.95).

Three Stations by Martin Cruz Smith is an Arkady Renko mystery set in Moscow where Renko must deal with a kidnapping, a murder and police corruption (Simon & Schuster, \$25.99)

The Mentor Leader by Tony Dungy draws on Biblical principles for insights about key concepts of mentor leadership (Tyndale, \$24.99)

Let's Take the Long Way Home by Gail Caldwell chronicles her friendship with fellow writer, the late Caroline Knapp including Caroline's battle with cancer (Random House, \$23.00)
